#### Who are we?

#### What personal data or information do we collect?

#### How do we collect data or information from you?

# How is your information used?

We collect your personal data or information to operate the business effectively and provide you with a high-quality service. We may use your information:

- To maintain security of our office and IT infrastructure

# **Clients / Prospective clients**

As a client, we will hold the following information about you:

- Name and contact information.

Billing and payment information.

We use Microsoft 365 for e-mail and document storage. We may sometimes use Dropbox or WeTransfer to send a large files to you or a supplier for your project.

We use Sage to manage billing and payment for our services.

We will retain your details for the duration of our relationship with you, then for 10 years after. We will retain financial records for 6 years, following the end of the current financial year.

#### **Suppliers**

When you work with the business as a supplier, we may hold the following information about you:

- Name and business contact information.
- Information relating to your qualifications, insurances and experience
- Information and documents relating to the services or products you offer, including our communications with you.
- Financial information

We store your information in our Microsoft 365 cloud service. We may also hold paper copies of your information stored in at our Office. Communications with you will be stored in our email system, which we use Microsoft 365 to manage. We will store your financial information in Sage.

#### Your Information and rights

#### Who has access to your information?

We do not sell or rent your personal data or information to any third party or share your information with third parties for their own marketing purposes.

We will disclose your data or information if required by law, for example by a court order or for the prevention of fraud or other crime.

We may pass your information on to third party service providers, agents or subcontractors for the purposes of completing a task or providing services to you on our behalf. However, we disclose only the personal information necessary to deliver that service and have a contract in place that requires them to keep your information secure and not to use it for other purposes.

You have certain rights over the processing of your personal information by Bond Construction. These are:

- The right to be informed, which is what this privacy policy is for
- The right to access the data we hold about you
- The right to object to direct marketing (we don't take part in any direct marketing or share/sell your data for these purposes)

- The right to object to processing carried out on the basis of legitimate interests
- The right to erasure (in some circumstances)

- The right to have your data rectified if it is inaccurate
- The right to have your data restricted or blocked from processing

Our site is hosted by Rackspace in London and uses Cloudflare to provide a secure barrier that provides complete DDoS protection. Our hosting is run by a company called Kovalent who manage the servers and their operation.

Our website works better with cookies enabled. Our cookies don't give us, or anyone else, access to your personal data. We advise you to keep cookies enabled.
